- Create and update quality metrics.
- Manage the Calibration Program.
- Obtain and maintain approval as a Designated Manufacturing Inspection Representative (DMIR) from the FAA.
- Manage the FAA Part 145 Repair Station and associated repairman.
- Support design, development, software applications, electronic and hardware assembly, and inspection/verification of each.

- Minimum ten years' experience with evidence of increasing responsibility in Quality Assurance field.
- Minimum five years' experience working with and/or managing an AS9100 Quality System. Knowledge of FAA Part 21 and 43, and 145 Requirements.
